Welcome to Willie Horton's 2010 Baseball Challenge where boys and girls have the opportunity to participate in a fun-filled event, at Comerica Park! Join Detroit Tigers legend, Willie Horton and 400 Detroit area youth as they participate in a youth development, baseball skills competition that promotes the enrichment of urban youth and recreational sports. No baseball experience is required.

Boys and girls, ages 5-15, will have a unique opportunity to:

- Visit Comerica Park and compete on a major league baseball field
- Display three fundamental baseball skills: batting, throwing and base-running
- Participate in Demonstration Clinics
- Earn a chance to be recognized at a Detroit Tigers Game

Every participant is provided an event T-shirt, food & beverages, and a baseball souvenir.

Youth will participate in the following age divisions:

5-7 year olds 8-10 year olds 11-12 year olds 13-15 year olds

Individual trophies for each skill will be awarded to the top boy and girl in each age division during the Tigers' game - Tuesday, August 3, 2010 - 7:05pm.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

Individuals should begin arriving at 8:00am for check-in. Each participant must have a completed Waiver/Release Form. **Those arriving after 9:45am are not guaranteed an opportunity to participate.** All participants and spectators should enter at Comerica Park - 2100 Woodward at GATE D on Montcalm Street.

Only participants will be allowed onto the infield. Spectators must observe from the stands. All participants should plan to be picked up from the event between 1:30pm and 2:00pm.

PARKING

Parking will be available in Parking Lot 3 on Montcalm Street for approximately \$3.

AWARDS

Winners will be announced at the end of the event on July 26th and awards distributed during a special pre-game awards ceremony on Tuesday, August 3, 2010 at the Tigers' home game.

ATTIRE

Participants must dress appropriately for athletic activity. Gym shoes and shorts should be worn. Participants wearing sandals, flip flops, skirts, etc. will not be allowed to participate for safety reasons. Please no jewelry or cleats of any kind. T-shirts will be provided.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of rain, the event will still take place as scheduled with alternate activities. Please contact Don Bosom Hall at 313.869.2200 to confirm the status of the event if weather conditions are questionable.
